



Transition visits have started for our honeybeeswho are heading off to school next year. There has been lots of excitement and chatter about all things school related between the group as we have children heading off to lots of different local schools. We have had a strong focus this term on supporting children's independence, self help skills and "have a go" attitudes; skills that will be important for all children next year, whether they are heading off to school or returning to kindergarten for another year of fun! Over the next few weeks we invite families to consider our children as capable little people and provide lots of opportunities to practice those independent skills; opening and closing containers, opening and closing packets, independently managing clothing, packing their bag extra! Lots of practice increases confidence in their own abilities.







Our Dolly Parton Imagination library (book gifting program) has finished up with the last book being received this month. This program has been funded through our School Readiness funding and we hope that it has been a wonderful way to share the love of books and reading with our honeybees. We have also finished the Peninsula Health KACH ME program which supported the growth and development of gross motor skills in a super fun and play based way! We have been able to incorporate lots of these ideas into our planning to compliment our program!


